In recognition of the EASA Supplemental Type Certification, 10071994, Revision A, for Elbe Flugzeugwerke GmbH conversion of passenger main cabin to class E cargo compartment in Airbus A321-231 model aircraft and the existing Technical Implementation Procedures for Airworthiness and Environmental Certification between the United States and Europe, we are pleased to issue Federal Aviation Administration Supplemental Type Certificate (STC) ST04493NY, issued June 17, 2020, to Elbe Flugzeugwerke GmbH. The corresponding FAA Project Number is ST08389NY-T (Ref. EASA Project Number 0060051700).

It is expected that as State of Design responsible for the STC, EASA will coordinate major/significant changes, with the FAA prior to EASA acceptance, in accordance with the Technical Implementation Procedures.
